Travel Itinerary

Thursday, July 21st
Depart from USA.

Friday, July 22nd
Upon your arrival in Nairobi, Kenya, you will be transported to your hotel for a good night's rest.

Saturday, July 23rd
Awake to a short morning flight where you can observe aerial views of the Maasai Mara, which you will explore on an afternoon Safari.

Sunday, July 24th
Spend your day spotting 'the big 5' on a Game Drive through the Maasai Mara during the height of the annual migration, one of the seven natural wonders of the world.

Monday, July 25th
Enjoy a morning driving through the breathtaking scenery of the Serengeti as you cross over into Tanzania. There you will enjoy a relaxing afternoon followed by a leisurely dinner as you take in the breathtaking sunset over the Serengeti.

Tuesday, July 26th
Experience rural Tanzania on your drive to tour the Mugumu Hospital & Nursing School. Spend the afternoon basking in the stunning sunset of the vast Serengeti.

Wednesday, July 27th
Upon your return to Nairobi, your afternoon will be spent touring Notre Dame's Dandora Hospital & Clinic that Matter outfitted with medical equipment. This hospital serves as a beacon of hope amidst Kenya's largest landfill. Your evening will be spent immersed in Kenya's culture through a traditional show.

Thursday, July 28th
Return to Dandora Hospital & School for a special student presentation, followed by lunch with the Notre Dame Fathers.
